Course description:
The aim of the reading seminar is for students to practice high-level textual analysis, interpretation and application through examples of specific literature on the subject of their doctoral thesis. Students will give presentations based on pre-defined studies and criteria. Participants will mutually evaluate and analyse each other's presentations and make suggestions for the content and academic stylistic requirements of the presentation. The literature covered in the seminar will depend on the topics of the doctoral students and will be determined on the first class of the semester. Each student is assigned five presentations during the semester.
